### Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance:

This Regular Council Meeting for the Town of Cusick, WA was called to order by Mayor Schofield at 06:00 PM.

# Review & Approve Meeting Minutes - 02/07/2023:

# Emergency Action/Non-Agenda Item:

Upon commencement of the meeting Everett Alford brought before the Council an emergency non-agenda item. Earlier in the day Everett had gone to STCU to request some documentation that he thought would be helpful as he and Luke begin their financial review. Upon looking at the account, the STCU employee informed Everett that there was quite a nt of activity on the Mayor's credit card. (At this time we are not sure why STCU failed to notify us or make any attempts to protect us from potential fraud.) Everett asked for a printout of all the activity which was provided. Upon review of the documentation, we have learned that there has been extensive fraud and theft from our accounts. We have also found unauthorized access to other accounts and services since. While we do not know exactly what methods were employed to gain access to our accounts, Council did discuss directing STCU to close our current accounts and reopen a new account which would hopefully serve to sever any unauthorized access.

Councilmember Tina Alford made a motion, which was seconded by Jessamyn Fitzhugh, that the Town close our current accounts with STCU and re-open a new account with completely new account numbers, user access, etc. The motion passed unanimously.

Councilmember Jessamyn Fitzhugh asked how quickly we thought this would happen as we need to issue elected payroll for this meeting. Luke said he didn't see why STCU couldn't do this pretty quickly as it would seem to just be a matter of moving data from one place to another.
